Consignment Contract:

- Virginia Feeders acts as an agent only and is not responsible for buyer/seller error or misunderstanding. Consignor/Seller agrees to 24-hour soundness guarantee on all catalog horses. If guaranteed horses are suspected of lameness within the 24-hour time frame, a Virginia Feeders agent and a designated veterinarian from Lewiston Vet Clinic will examine horse and make the final judgment. If the horse is deemed lame, sale will be terminated and consignor will be responsible for taking the horse back, consignor forfeits their fees, and buyer will not be charged. Virginia Feeders will care for the horse for up to 48 hours, giving time for the consignor to pick up the horse.
- All other guarantees are strictly between the buyer and seller. Parties will hold harmless Virginia Feeders and auctioneer for any legal action that may arise from the sale.
- All leg wrapping or any other wrapping must be removed prior to entering the sale ring. Consignor certifies that their horse is sound and healthy, unless otherwise noted on the consignment form. Horses which are unsound in eyes, wind, are "windsuckers" or "cribbers", or are known of lameness must be so announced or will be subject to the 24-hour guarantee.
- Virginia Feeders and its employees/agents/representatives will not be responsible for any injury or loss of any animal or accidents thereby or any injury or loss of life to any participants or spectators during the sale event.
- Horses will be sold as registered only if the original papers and signed transfers are furnished to Virginia Feeders before the sale. Copies of both papers and transfers may be mailed in at the time of consignment. If the consignor wants to sell the horse as registered, they must supply the original papers at check in or the horse will be considered grade and sold as such.
- The commission will be 8% of the selling price or the minimum of \$100, whichever is greater. Consignor has the privilege to no sale or pass out their horse. It is the seller's responsibility to notify the auctioneer of the no sale before leaving the sale ring. If the horse is passed out, \$100 of the consignment fee will be held to cover costs as a no sale fee. The catalog fee is non-refundable.
- Consignor is responsible for declaring HYPP status of impressive bred horses. All mares that will be sold as bred must have a Vet Certificate issued within ten days of the sale stating that the mare has been checked and is with foal, otherwise the mare will be sold as open. A signed breeders report must be included with the mare's registration papers and signed transfer, otherwise the foal will be considered to be grade.
- All consignments must go through the sale ring. It is the seller's responsibility to get their horse to and from the sale ring at its designated time to sell. Consignor agrees to not privately sell or withdraw consigned horse to sale unless injured or sick with vet release. A \$200 never offered fee will be charged to the consignor if no vet release is provided. Alley trading will be permitted after the conclusion of the sale only. All transactions must be run through Virginia Feeders horse sale office. This is a contract; you are consigning your horse to sell at the horse. Sale.
- All horses must be in compliance with State of Idaho transportation regulations.
- Virginia Feeders reserves the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and regulations and arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions, or differences in regard to the sale. All consignors will be held to the terms and conditions of this contract whether or not consignors have read them.
- The law of the State of Idaho shall govern the interpretation of any and all disputes or other matters relating to the sale. The consignor agrees to pay any and all reasonable attorney's fees and costs incurred by Virginia Feeders or its employees/agents/representatives in the commencement or defense of any actions. Venue and jurisdiction of any and all disputes which may arise by virtue of the auction sale shall be in the court of Nez Perce County, Idaho.
- Sale proceeds will be mailed on Wednesday, March 24, 2021.

****All consignments MUST include the following****

1. Completed Consignment Entry Form (page 1)
2. Signed Consignment Contract Form (page 2)
3. \$200 Consignment Fee, \$100 will be reimbursed after the animal sells.
 - a. Check must be received by entry due date, February 15, 2021.
4. Picture of Horse
5. Original Registration Papers on all Registered Horses with signed transfer.
 - a. Copy may be mailed in with consignment forms.
6. Current Coggins and Health Inspections (ALL horses, in and out of state)
7. Current Brand Inspection (Horses coming from outside of Idaho)
8. Optional Video (ring side televisions are available to play videos while your horse sells).

AN OPEN CONSIGNMENT SESSION WILL ALSO BE OFFERED THE DAY OF THE SALE. All open consignment horses will still be subject to State of Idaho brand and health laws, as previously stated in consignment contract.

CHECK IN TIME WILL BE SATURDAY, MARCH 20 FROM 8:00 – 10:00AM. All paperwork, including health and brands MUST be turned in by 10:00 to sell your horse.

HORSES WILL BE SOLD IN RANDOM CATALOG ORDER.
A NUMBER PAINT BRAND WILL BE GIVEN FOLLOWING CHECK IN.

ENTRIES WILL BE PROVIDED STALLS AND BEDDING BY VIRGINIA FEEDERS.
BRING YOUR OWN FEED AND WATERING BUCKETS.
